COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT SITE PLAN CHECKLIST

A Site Plan must be provided that is based on a Survey prepared by a Registered Surveyor. The Site Plan shall be prepared and signed by a Registered Surveyor, Landscape Architect, Engineer, or Architect. Provide three (3) copies.

This Site Plan must include:

1) A statement describing in narrative form the character and intended use of the
development and the current zoning classification of the property
2) Owner's name, address and phone number
3) Vicinity Map
4) Name of the project, name of the planner, name of the developer
5) Date and revision dates of the Site Plan
6) North Arrow
7) Based upon an exact survey of the property, drawn to a scale of not less than 1" = 40', show the following:
Boundaries of the project, adjacent existing streets, state waters within 200 linear feet, lakes, creeks, wetlands, etc., as well as building setbacks, easements or other encumbrances
Exact location and dimensions of all existing and proposed buildings
and structure including each floor level and roof peak relative to
mean sea level((MSL)
Access ramps, sidewalks, highways curb cuts, existing and proposed
All screens and buffers existing and required by zoning
Refuse collection provisions (dumpsters and pads are not allowed in setbacks)
Access to all utilities and details of connections
A Right-of-Way Permit is required for any work performed in Wayne
County rights-of-way in addition to all other permits
8) Drainage Design Report prepared by a licensed Georgia Professional Engineer
including:
A. Narrative of the proposed drainage plan
B. Drainage area map with time of concentration pathway
C. Runoff coefficient calculations with pipe size calculations
D. Pre-development and post-development runoff calculations
9) Signage- show location and size of all exterior visible signage 10) Tree survey of all trees 24" diameter or more at 4.5' from base
11) Flood Hazard Area Statement- show specific zone(s) and demarcation lines
between any zones on the site
12) Sedimentation and Erosion Control Permit, if required
13) Storm Water NOI must be submitted to GA EPD with copy to Wayne County
Inspection Department a minimum of 14 days prior to beginning construction on site
larger than 1 acre
